#### **SAB Newlands Brewery Tour, ERF46604 Boundary Rd, Newlands, Cape Town, 7700**

The outing on the 13th August will take place at Newlands Brewery situated across the road from the conference venue, Sports Science Institute of South Africa (SSISA). The History of Newlands dates back to 1657, when the first brewing licence was granted to Pieter Visagie; who made his beer on the banks of the Liesbeek River. Later, in 1859, the historical Mariendahl Brewery was completed by Jacob Letterstedt. This eventually became Ohlssons Cape Breweries (OCB) in 1888 where Lion Lager was first produced.

Charles Glass, the founder brewer of Castle Lager, competed with OCB until eventually both companies merged in 1956. Newlands has been an area rich in beer history for the last 360 years. The tour will cover the history in more detail, as well as how our legendary brands are produced and distributed. The tour wouldn't be complete without a tasting – which you will receive after the tour. Through history, every sip of our legendary beers have stood testimony to the fact that when you spend so much time practicing, you eventually get rather good at it.
